Decisions:

Each site needs to fulfil minimum requirements.

For the interviews, the minimum is 2 people per stakeholder group (patient, clinician, supporter, admin), but sites are strongly encouraged to meet the original targets of 10 patients, 5 clinicians, 5 supporters, and 5 admins if they can.

For the surveys, the minimum is 25% of the target (rounded down). So 25 patients, 12 supporters, 5 clinicians, and 2 admins.

All targets are per country, not per site.
